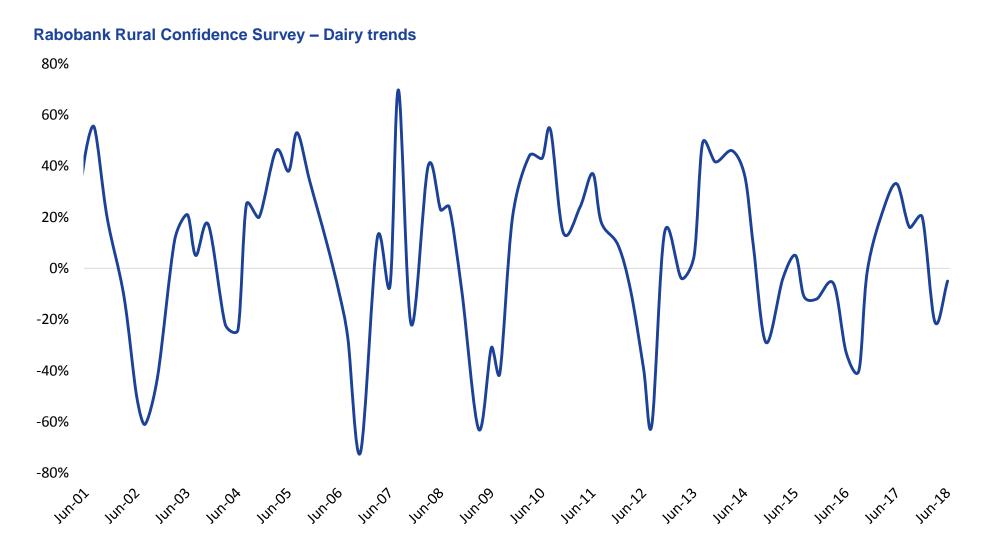

Dairy farmer confidence levels slowly on the mend



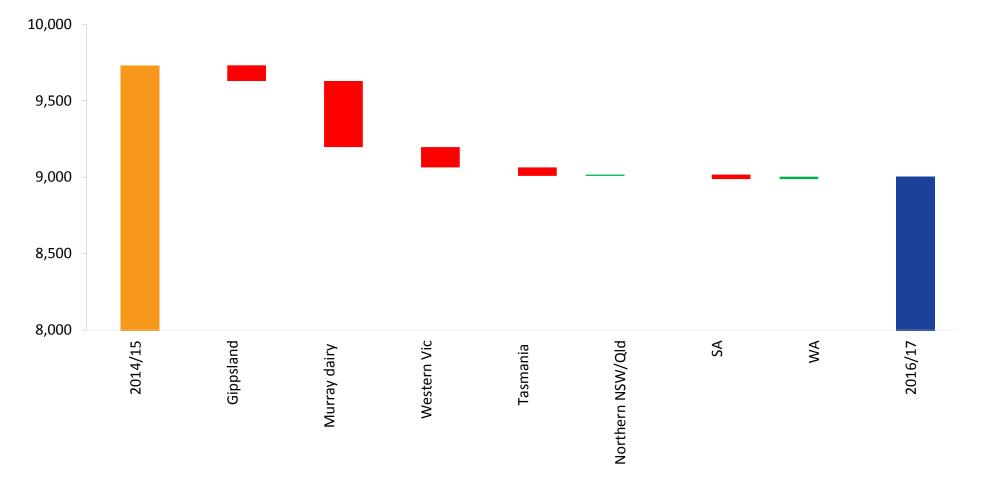

Australia lost a lot of milk over a two-season period



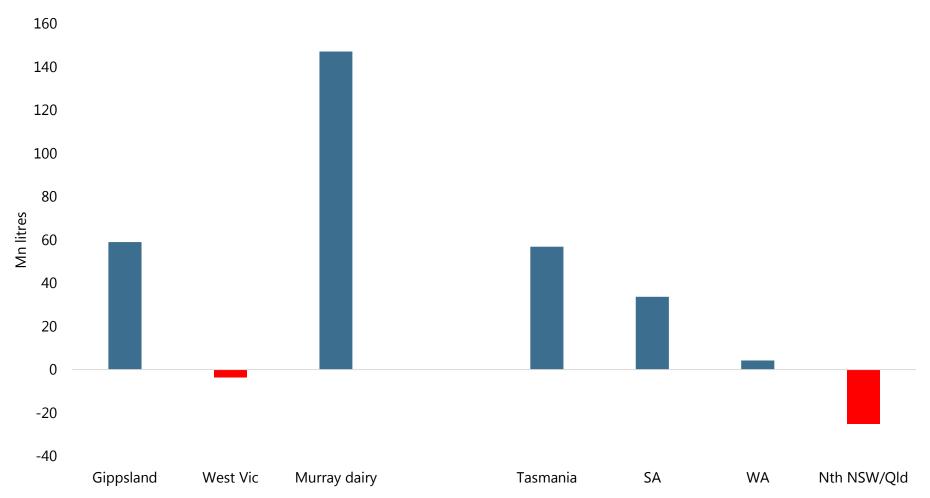
Australian milk supply, 2014/15 vs 2016/17 (mn litres)



A recovery in milk supply has been patchy

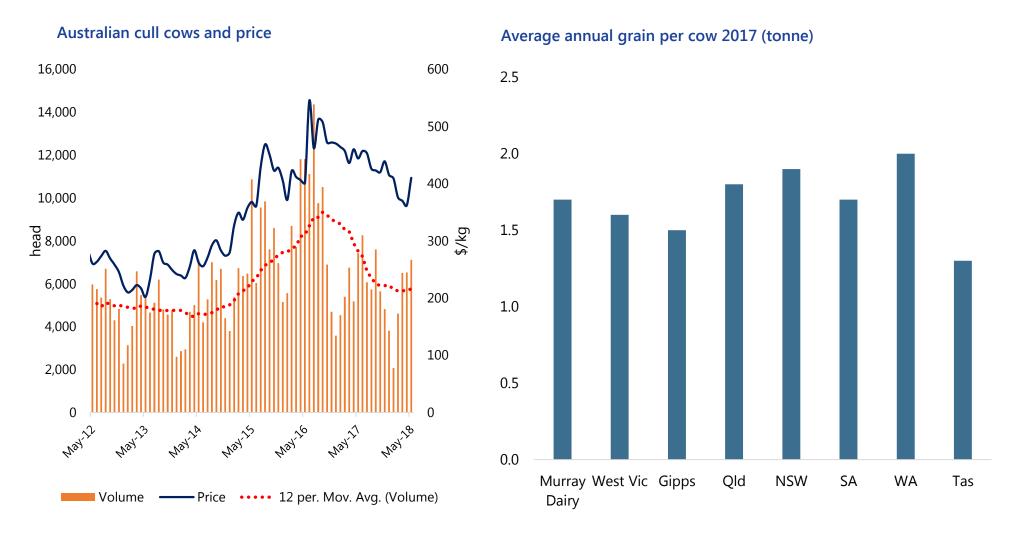


Milk supply growth in 2017/18, as at April2018



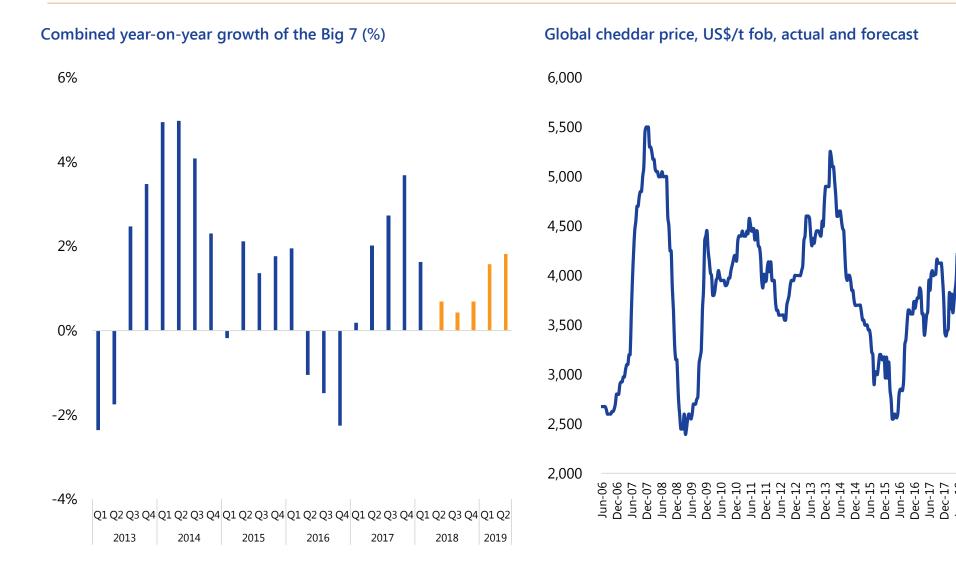
The herd rebuild will be slow





Steady as she goes now for global markets





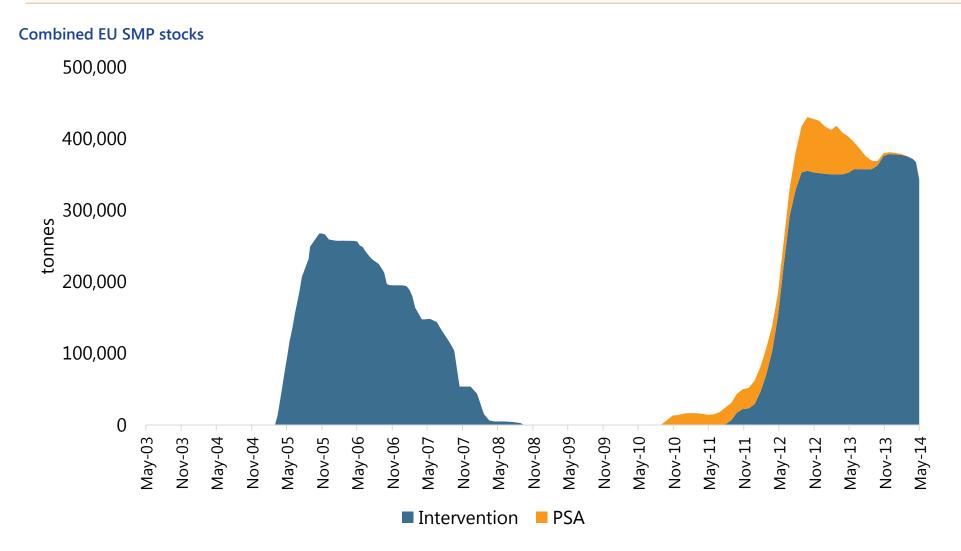

The heat is on for milk supply earlier than normal

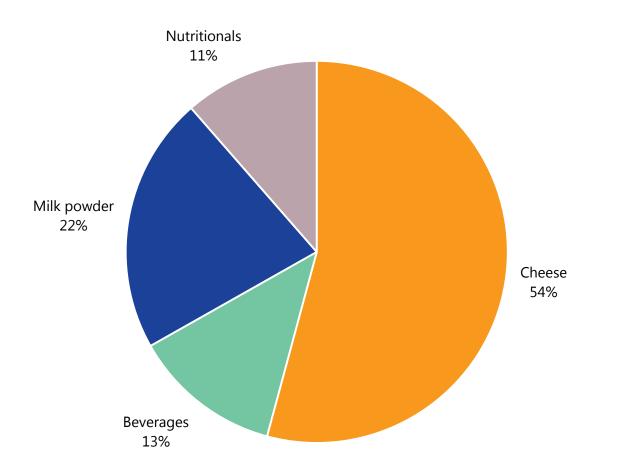




As Australia moves towards a cheese play



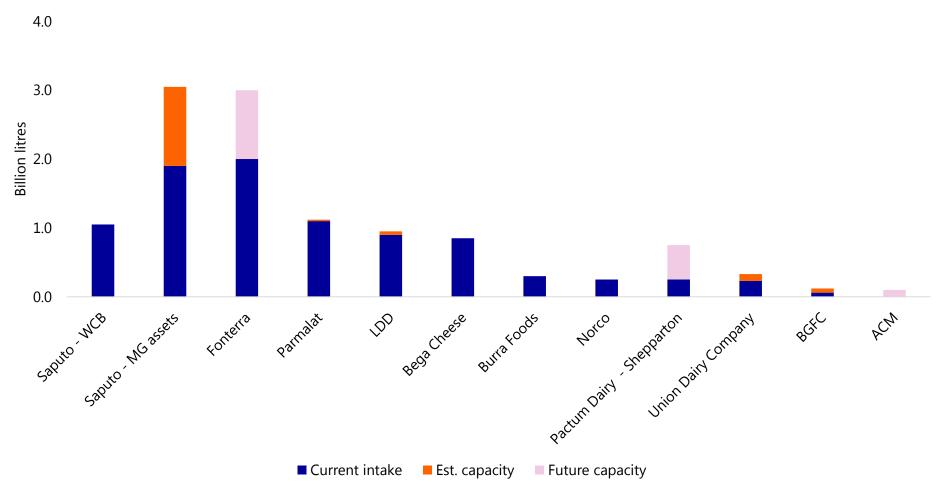
Dairy processing capacity expansions since 2015 (actual and announced)



Competitive pressure for supply will be an ongoing feature

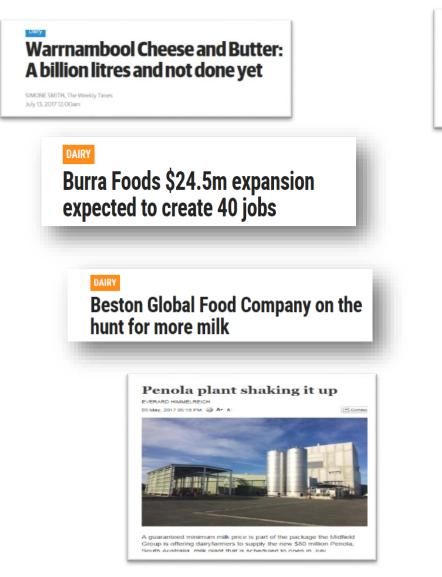


Annual milk intake, current and forecast

Milk pools are being repositioned at a faster rate







- Dairy farmer sentiment has improved; but remains cautious for major investments.
- Global markets have found a healthy supply-demand balance.
- This will support southern Australia farmgate milk prices in 2018/19.
- But margins will be squeezed by higher feed and water costs in 2018/19.
- There continues to be major change taking place across the Australia dairy supply chain.
- This includes a shift in:
 - Ownership structure of the supply chain
 - Who is collecting and processing the milk
 - What product streams are taking the milk components
 - How milk is being priced at the farmgate
- The long-term challenge is for Australian to generate sustained growth in milk supply.
